<u>Five Local Students Receive</u> <u>\$500.00 Scholarships from</u> <u>Cruisers</u>

Five receive scholarships from Azalea City Cruisers

Four Putnam County senior high school students received \$500.00 scholarships each from the Azalea City Cruisers. The club gives these scholarships to seniors who plan on attending vocational or technical schools after high school. The scholarships were awarded at the senior awards programs at the high schools. This year private and home-schooled students were allowed to apply for this scholarship.

The school winners were HEATHER O'KELLY and DALTON WILKINSON at Crescent City High School and AL-EXANDREA DEEL and TANNER McMANN at Interlachen High School. These students plan on a career that requires education past a high school diploma, but not necessarily requires a college degree. Students must have better than a "C" average and complete an essay about their future plans and career choice.

Also, this year, JORDAN (CADE) CHASTAIN, received a second \$500.00 scholarship. He graduated from Palatka High School in 2020. He is now attending SJRSC.

This is the fifteenth year these scholarships have been awarded. The Azalea City Cruisers is more than just a club that promotes the preservation of the American hot rod; they are also a charitable organization. They raise money for cancer research, needy cancer patients, and the Lee Conlee House for battered and abused women. Money is raised from sponsors, car shows and cruise-ins. The club holds cruise-ins at Pizza Boyz in Palatka on the fourth Saturday of each month from 5 to 8 pm. and the fifth Saturday of the month at Salt Springs Pizza from 4 to 7pm. The club's annual October car show will be held this year at the Putnam County Fairground on October 2nd.

ALBERT AND KATHY **GRONBACH**



So now you can put a face with a car and a car with a face, the next time you see them say hello and welcome.





Thank you Bob, both trips sound like lots of fun!


Our monthly Pizza Boyz Cruise In was a wash out, too much rain! See you at our next one on July 24th.
